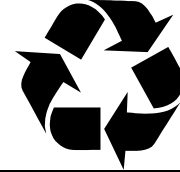
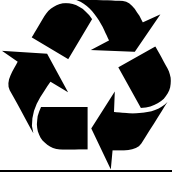


RECYCLING RULES & PROCEDURES

Recycling Center Open

Summer: Thursday 1-5, Sat. 9-5, Sun. 9-1

Winter: Thursday 1-4, Sat. 9-4, Sun, 9-1

- Corrugated cardboard & brown paper bags:
MUST be broken down and flattened.
- Glass containers only: No Pyrex, window, or light bulbs.
- Magazines, Newsprint, & phone books combined
- Mixed Paper: Cereal boxes, junk mail, egg cartons
- Used motor oil
- Used Antifreeze
- Plastic containers: #2 neutral (milk jugs) and colored (HDPE), flattened if possible
- Tin/Aluminum cans
- Packing material: Styrofoam peanuts and bubble wrap
- Any rechargeable batteries
- 4' & 8' fluorescent light bulbs
- Rechargeable batteries
- Printer Cartridges, (Laser & Ink Jet)
- Cellphones

Swap Shop – ‘Take it or leave it’

Note: All items MUST be clean, dry, in usable condition and in bags or boxes.

- Books, Clothing, Dishes
- Games, puzzles and hobby materials
- Household items
- Shoes/Boots

Compost at home

- Leaves, garden, and yard clippings
- Kitchen waste, peelings, coffee grounds

Dresden Transfer Station

Note: All materials must be in plastic or Sturdy paper bags; Leaves and yard waste are not accepted.

A token must accompany each bag - \$1 for up to 15lbs \$2 up to 35lbs, purchasable at the Town Office or at the Transfer Station.

Anything that is not recyclable, such as:

- Plastics other than #2
- Ceramic items
- Dirty or contaminated paper
- Dishes or glassware other than jars/containers
- Rubber items
- Styrofoam board

Alternative Disposal Locations

Richmond Holding Area: Outer Lincoln St, Richmond
Open the 1st and 3rd weekend of each month except Jan > Mar.

- White Goods: No charge
- Bulky Goods: Furniture, mattresses, for a fee (See attendant)
- Tires: With or without rims, for a fee (See attendant)
- Clean wood or brush: No charge
- Clean metal: No charge

Bath Landfill: High St, Bath 443-8356

All of the above except **used motor oil and yard wastes**; You provide transportation and tipping fees.
