Reference: RSU2 Student Food Program/Food Distribution

The purpose of this notice is to inform the parents and students of Regional School Unit 2 (RSU2) **residing in Richmond and Dresden ONLY**, how students will be able to access school food during the ongoing COVID-19 health crisis.

On Thursday March 19<sup>th</sup> and Friday March 20<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 11:00am and 1:00pm the Town of Richmond will be handing out school food at the Richmond Police Department located at 26 Gardiner Street. Parents/students will be asked to use the parking lot located behind the Police Department. You will see signs on the rear of the Police Department building directing you where to pick up your school food.

Due to concerns for both public and Town Employee safety we ask that parents/students only approach the food table one at a time. When you approach the food table please indicate to the Town Employee how many lunches you need. Once you receive your food you are asked to leave the food table and allow the next parent/student to approach. We further ask that individuals spend as little time in the parking lot as possible in an effort to minimize health concerns. If you are showing any symptoms of COVID-19 you are asked not to come to the food distribution site.

Tentatively the Town of Richmond is planning to continue this program starting on Monday March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Information regarding this will be posted on the Town's website, [www.richmondmaine.com](http://www.richmondmaine.com) as well as the Town's Facebook page.

Please note, this is a cooperative effort between the Town of Richmond and RSU2. All food is provided by RSU2. The Town of Richmond is only responsible for distributing the food. The Town of Richmond is not responsible for the quantity/quality/type of the food. In the event RSU2 is unable to provide school food for this program, the program will end.

**REMINDER: Only Students of RSU2 residing in Richmond and Dresden are eligible to receive food from this program.**
